



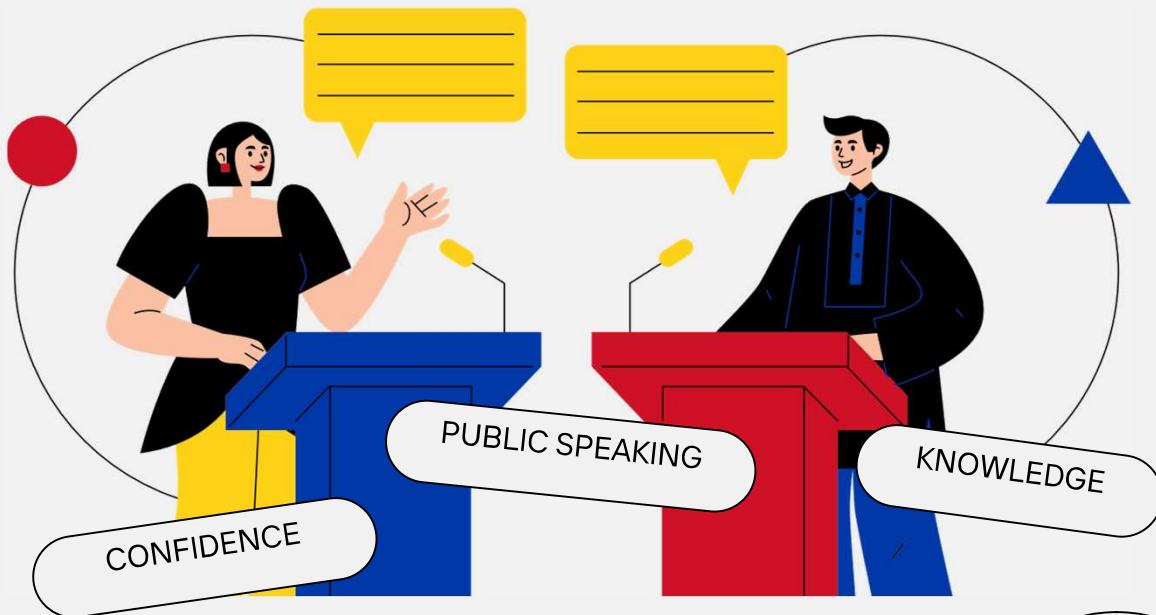

## **Students' Eligibility:**

- Students registered for Intermediate Course.
- Students registered for Final Course and are undergoing articleship training.
- Students who have completed their Articleship are not eligible to participate.
- Students are allowed to participate only from the branch with which they are registered for articleship/of the concerned level of course pursued.
- The student participated in from one branch shall not be allowed to participate from another branch.
- Students will be allowed to participate in any one of the Competition announced in this year.



## **GUIDELINES FOR DEBATE:**

- The debate will in 'For & Against the motion' format and the topic shall be chosen by the participants from the list mentioned in the following slide.
- Two participants (one 'For' and one 'Against' the motion on a given topic) will participate in a round.
- The medium of the debate will be English only.
- In the final round, each pair will be allotted a total of 10 minutes, divided as follows:
  - 3 minutes per speaker for presenting arguments (For/ Against)
  - 2 minutes per speaker for the Rebuttal / Counter-Argument Round
- During the rebuttal round, in case of any disruption, the judge's decision regarding whether a speaker may continue will be final.
- In case of any conflict or dispute, the judges' decision will be final and binding.
- Students should submit their mobile phones, smartwatch, earphones, or any other gadget which can be misused during the competitions



## **TOPICS FOR DEBATE:**

- Should AI be granted some form of legal personhood?
- Should companies have the right to collect and sell consumer data without consent?
- Does social media enhance or degrade interpersonal communication?
- Is economic growth always beneficial, or should we prioritize sustainability over expansion?.
